What is Copyright?

Copyright is a form of protection provided by the laws of the United States (title 17, U.S. Code) to the authors of "original works of authorship" including literary, dramatic, musical, artistic and certain other works. This protection is available to both published and unpublished works.

What This Has to do with the KODAK Picture Maker.

Since people will be using the KODAK Picture Maker to make copies of their photographs, they will need to understand what they are and are not allowed to do.

All photographs are protected by copyright. It is perfectly legal for a person to use the KODAK Picture Maker to copy or enlarge photographs that they themselves took. However, if the photographs they are enlarging were taken by a professional photographer or anyone else other than the person bringing in the print, then the permission of the photographer is needed. Be sure people understand that it is illegal to copy other people's work without their permission.
